- 01. Overall Trailer Length: 14ft. minimum. (Important) Tongue may be extended to reach the 14-foot minimum. No material may extrude from the back of Trailer. All trailers require cargo that must be secured. ALL cargo and Trailer components must be removed from Corrigan Oil Speedway property.
- 02. Trailer cannot be rigged to self-destruct, leaving only frame to continue racing, and must be able to race without falling apart. Trailers should be destroyed only upon impact with another vehicle.
- 03. Glass as well as any debris must be removed from cargo area.
- 04. Absolutely no campers, house trailers or fiberglass boats.
- 05. Tongue must be attached to tow vehicle by ball hitch, free pivoting. Safety chains and equalizer bars are not allowed. NO PINTLE HITCHES. NO CLASP TYPE HITCHES.
- 06. Ballast or weight may not be added.
- 07. Tow vehicle can be truck, van or car. No 4-wheel drives.
- 08. Trailers must be one solid component. (No pivot or chained components)
- 09. No Antifreeze in radiator.
- 10. Helmets, Fire-Suit, Gloves, Neck Brace and 5-Point Harness Required.
- 11. No sharp edges that could cut competitors tires.

12. Vehicles must have at least one of the following safety features:

- Option #1: A full cage
- Option #2: A steel plate at least 1/4" thick that overlaps each end of the driver's door by at least 6 inches and is at least 14" inches high, and is secured with at least (4) 1/2 inch bolts. A spreader bar (large bar, I-beam, pipe just behind seat connecting one side of car to other at bumper height approximately 12" inches off the floor with at least a 8"x 8" plate attached to the bar connected to both sides of the car) required. With out a cage or spreader bar, cars are not eligible to run.

Other means that meet or exceed the above options and are deemed safe by Corrigan Oil Speedway Techs.

- 13. Additional rules may be added if needed. Objective of race: Finish race with your trailer attached while separating the trailers of your competitors from their tow vehicle. If you lose your trailer, you will be DQ'd and you will be black flagged. If you hit another tow vehicle with your vehicle you will be DQ'd immediately. Trailers that have lost their wheels or may damage the racing surface will be DQ'd. Length of race is 10 laps unless only one trailer/tow vehicle combo remains intact. In that event they will be declared the winner.
- 14. Purse: Announced prior to event date.
 - 1. \$300
 - 2. \$125
 - 3. \$75
 - Rest \$50
- 15. Flags will be displayed in Tums 1, 2 and 4 with Tum #4 being the Green and Checker Flags. In the event of a black flag the car # will be displayed on a Board in Tum #1. Failure to comply with the black flag will result in forfeiture of purse money.

No registration fees. Feature starting position is determined by random draw.
